Non-winning submissions may be picked up at the Chamber office during the month of April.

(After April 27, 2019, any remaining artwork will become the property of the Chamber)

Contest Rules

When designing the piece of art, please keep in mind that the poster is a vital element to the success of the National Shrimp Festival. The artwork that is chosen will not only become the official poster, but it will also add to the development of the retail merchandise.

Poster artwork **MUST** incorporate the following elements:

- Festival Themes: **Art, Food, and Music**
- Festival Year: **2019**
- Festival Location: **Gulf Shores / Orange Beach, Alabama**
- Festival Name: **48th Annual National Shrimp Festival**
- Actual size of poster artwork must be 18 inches horizontal by 24 inches vertical. (leave border area)
- Poster should be done on poster board, paper, canvas or a medium that can easily be scanned and reproduced if chosen as winner.

The winning artist will receive a one-time payment of \$1,000.00. If winning artist is under the age of 18, artist must have parent's signature on contract to receive prize money.

The artist will include additional small elements from submitted artwork to be potentially used for official Shrimp Festival merchandise. (artwork suitable for left chest design and hats/visors)

The winning artist agrees to relinquish ownership of artwork.

The winning artwork becomes sole property of Coastal Alabama Business Chamber and Annual National Shrimp Festival and may be used in any manner the Chamber desires without further compensation to the artist.

The winning artist agrees to sign and number 100 prints within a 30 day request.

The winning artist agrees to be present for a minimum of four hours on Saturday, October 12, 2019 to sign posters and souvenirs for festival attendees (Saturday attendance is required).
